ExcITe CUP 2025 consists of the following competitions:

1. On Spot Programming competition
2. Software Project Exhibition
3. Quiz
4. Poster Design competition
5. E-Gaming
6. Table Tennis
7. Thematic Video Design

1. On Spot Programming Competition

In the Programming Competition of ExcITe CUP 2025 teams would be given a set of problems and they will have to solve problems in a given time. The teams can solve the problems in Python, C++ and Java. For Programming competition, teams must be registered by May 10, 2025.

Rules of Programming Competition:

1. **Team Composition**
 - Each team consists of maximum three contestants.
2. **Basic Eligibility Requirements**
 - A student must be enrolled in a degree program at the team's institution.
 - **Participant must bring his/her valid university identity card on the day of event.**
3. **Scoring of a Provincial Contest**
 - Teams are ranked according to the most problems solved. For awards, teams who solve the same number of problems are ranked by least total time.
4. **Contest Computing Environment**
 - The programming languages of the contest will include C++, Java and Python.
 - Each team will use a single workstation.
 - Stationery (Pages, pencils etc.) will be provided to the participants.
 - Participant can submit his/her solution in a specified folder in the specified time.

2. Quiz Competition

Basic Eligibility Requirements

A student must be enrolled in a degree program at the team's institution.

Participant must bring his/her valid university identity card on the day of event.

The quiz competition would be comprised of the following subjects:

1. Operating Systems
2. Databases
3. Automata Theory
4. Data Structures
5. Algorithms
6. Programming
7. Computer Architecture
8. Software Engineering
9. Computer Networks

Rules of Quiz Competition:

- There would be maximum three members in each team.
- Each MCQs will be given maximum 20 seconds to answer.
- The team should first listen to complete question and then answer.

3. Poster Design Competition

In this competition, participants would be given a topic and they have to design a poster on the given topic using Adobe Photoshop/Corel Draw.

Basic Eligibility Requirements

A student must be enrolled in a degree program at the team's institution.

Participant must bring his/her valid university identity card on the day of event.

Rules of the Poster Competition:

- **There would be only one participant in each team.** There is no limit on number of teams from a university.
- Students will bring their own laptops with all necessary tools/technologies etc. However, the university will provide systems if needed.
- There would be a specific time allocated for the competition.
- At the end of the time, participants would submit their posters in a specified folder in any of the following formats: JPG (.jpg), PNG (.png), GIF (.gif) or PDF.
- The minimum required size for the poster is 560 pixels × 1100 pixels (height × width).

4. Software Project Exhibition

In this competition, participants would display their undergraduate project that they have done in their degree program.

Basic Eligibility Requirements

A student must be enrolled in a degree program at the team's institution.

Participant must bring his/her valid university identity card on the day of event.

Rules of Software Project Competition:

- Each team consists of maximum three contestants.
- Participants need to come with their complete project.
- They also need to display the poster of their project. Poster size should be 2 feet wide and 5 feet long.
- The poster should contain the title, abstract, tools and technologies that they have used.

Basic Eligibility Requirements

Game Rules

- a) The home and away team selection will be on toss. The winning person will choose the team of his own choice first and can choose whether to play international match or club match.
- b) No customized settings are allowed For Example:
 - i. legacy defending
 - ii. Custom tactics

If Disconnection Occurs during a Match

- If electrical failure occurs the match is to be resumed and each team keeps the number of goals scored and the time consumed in the previous match which can't be completed will be neglected in new game. For Example if the game crashed in 30 minutes play, then the new match will only be played for 60 minutes and then will be ended.
- A failure happening during the first 20 minutes leads to restart of the entire match.
- A player will only be given 1 minute to make substitution during the match

Additional Rules

- ◆ If a player does not agree to any rules, he/she can express his/her protest to a Match Referee before the completion of a match.
- ◆ If a re-match is decided by the head, the team that does not follow this decision will be subject to disqualification.
- ◆ Decision of match referee will be final and cannot be challenged.

MATCH PROCEDURES

Basic Eligibility Requirements

A student must be enrolled in a degree program at the team's institution.

Participant must bring his/her valid university identity card on the day of event.

The Rules of Table Tennis Competition:

- Singles competitions will be arranged separately for both girls and boys.
- The event will be held on a knockout basis.
- International table tennis rules will be followed.
- Each game is played to 11 points, except that if the score reaches 10-all, the game continues until one player leads by 2 points.
- Each match will be the best of the 3 games.
- Each player serves 2 points in a row and then the server is switched.
- Offensive or disruptive behavior will not be tolerated.
- The referee's decision will be considered final.

7. Thematic Video Design

The Video design event is an exciting competition where teams create short videos based on assigned themes across three rounds. Participants will showcase their creativity and technical skills in video design.

Basic Eligibility Requirements

A student must be enrolled in a degree program at the team's institution.

Participants must bring his/her valid university identity card on the day of the event.

Rules for the Video-Making Event:

- **Team Composition:** Each team will consist of maximum 03 members. Only registered members may participate in the event.
- **Theme Announcement:** Themes for each round will be announced at the start of the round, and teams will have a limited time to prepare their videos.
- **Video Duration:** Videos must adhere to the specified lengths: 3 minutes for Round 1, 5 minutes for Round 2, and 10 minutes for Round 3.
- **Original Content:** All videos must be original and created by the participating team members. Plagiarism or use of copyrighted material will result in disqualification.
- **Submission Format:** Videos must be submitted in a specified format (e.g., MP4) by the deadline for each round.
- **Winning Process:** Teams will compete in all rounds, with the winners determined by the highest aggregate score across all three rounds.
- **Equipment Usage:** Teams will bring their own equipment including laptops, software installed, cameras, tripods, etc.
